BROUGHAM VALUES SOAR PER NEW N.A.D.A GUIDE

A lot of us remember the days when a near perfect Brougham could not fetch more than \$4000.00. More recently, we seemed to have topped out at \$30,000-\$40,000 and holding with very little hope on the horizon of seeing another significant increase. The April 1996 N.A.D.A. guide showed a 1957-58 Brougham at \$27,600, \$5,400 less than a comparable Biarritz convertible. Hold on to your hats-the new May-August N.A.D.A. guide now lists the 1957-58 Brougham at \$60,000, \$18,000 more than the Biarritz convertible. The 1959 is now at \$32,000 and the 1960 at \$31,000. Our cars are finally getting the respect they always deserved. It has indeed been a long uphill battle bringing to the attention of the world a true American classic. I believe the Brougham was the victim of a campaign of misunderstanding that lasted many many years. The fact that so many Broughams are now being seen, that have been restored to their former glory, and seen by a new generation of automobile enthusiasts has lead to a fresh appreciation of the technical and styling masterpiece that has always been the Eldorado Brougham. Publication after publication has featured the Brougham and the effect is now being felt. We are in debt to those who made their cars available to enlighten so many. We all know the difficulties that our brave Brougham restorers have had to overcome to have the impressive cars as we have seen in some of the top automotive magazines. A few years back, we were called crazy to put so much effort into a seemingly futile venture. We may never be known for our sanity, but we will be known for leaving the world a better place to enjoy the lost art of the American automobile. Next time you show your Brougham, watch the faces of the spectators to savor the desire they feel to return to the grand old days of dreams becoming reality. You will not see that look in any new car showroom. Corporate America has lost that touch. But, that is is a subject for a future article or book.

The following is the main body of my most recent letter to N.A.D.A. regarding Brougham values. I hope that you agree that vanities are worthy of consideration when pricing a Brougham.

Dear Sirs:

I am writing in regards to the significant options on the 1957/1958 Cadillac Eldorado Brougham. Since the 57/58 Broughams did not list any options, a very important fact is often overlooked when appraising these cars. As standard equipment the Brougham came with 1. A lady's vanity case containing comb, lipstick, powder and powder puff, all specially created for Cadillac by the Evan's Company. 2. (6) magnetized drinking cups in a plastic holder. 3. A plastic Cigarette case. 4. A note pad and Cross pencil in a leather holder. 5. A beveled mirror with a leather back. 6. A 1 oz. bottle of Lanvin Arpege parfume with an atomizer top. As one might expect, these items quickly disappeared as Broughams changed hands. Attempts have been made to reproduce these items; however, a Brougham is not complete without them. Owner's have been known to buy entire cars to get a missing vanity item. Consideration should be given to this fact when pricing a Brougham with and without vanities. I have owned Broughams since 1962 and can say in all honesty that items like the perfume bottle are just not to be had. As an antiques dealer I have spent a lot of time searching for the atomizer bottles with very little success.

A Brougham with all vanity items should bring at least \$10,000 more than one without them. Mention should be made of this in the guide. Deductions should be made for missing items. Should you have any further questions on these items please contact me.

THIS IS THE ELDORADO BROUGHAM BY CADILLAC

You are the 00816 visitor.

The car featured this page is number 466, a 1958 owned by <u>Allan W. Dowling President</u> Brougham Owner's Association, Inc.

In the fall of 1957, as promised two years earlier, Cadillac brought to limited production their Eldorado Brougham Motorama "Dream Car". Designed by Robert Scheelk, the Brougham was the realization of the life long ambition of Cadillac's styling chief -Harley Earl. The hyper - luxurious Brougham was



described by Cadillac management as "The most advanced automobile ever built and a mirror of things to come". It is still the most complex car ever offered to the American public with features not yet found on today's cars.




The price for this car was, in 1957, a staggering \$13,074.00 making it the most expensive production car in the world. All this in the days when you could buy a top of the line Biarritz convertible for \$6500.00 or a Rolls Royce Saloon for about \$9000.00.

These chariots were typically owned by movie stars, wealthy industrialists, and a gangster or two. Bob Hope, John Wayne, Frank Sinatra, Aristotle Onasis, are but a few of the original Brougham owners. For their money they took delivery of the most opulently equipped car ever to come out of Detroit. Interior



appointments included a lady's compact, magnetized drinking cups, cigarette case, lipstick holder, beveled mirror, note pad and pencil, mouton carpeting, and even a perfume atomizer filled with Arpege extrait de lanvin parfume from Paris. The Brougham was for those privileged few who could afford a car of the future while living in the present.



The Brougham marked industry firsts in all sorts of technological advances and luxury: air suspension, electronic memory seat, electric door locks, full opening and closing power trunk, power automatic antenna, even an automatic starter that allowed the owner to turn the key and sit back while the Brougham "started itself". The front and rear bumpers as well as the wheels were cast chrome plated aluminium. The

Brougham was powered by a special multiple carburated engine that developed 335 h.p. All mechanical components of the Brougham were "select fit" and run in before installation.

Only 704 Broughams were produced during 1957 and 1958 These magnificent cars are distinguished by their stainless steel roof panels and "suicide doors". Production of the totally re-styled 1959 Pinninfarinia bodied Broughams was 99. 101 1960 Broughams were completed before the Eldorado Brougham was discontinued The cost of producing cars of the Brougharn's stature was more than Cadillac wanted to absorb. Every Brougham was produced at a



considerable loss. The Brougham was the height of elegance, the ultimate personal luxury car. Unsurpassed even today, the Eldorado Brougham stands out as the best example of the post war love of the American automobile.

It is very difficult to to copy pictures from the Internet to a hard copy and again transfer them to print. When you view the pictures on the net the quality is superb and they are in color. I hope that you all have a chance to see the pages presented here in all their glory on a good computer monitor. The Internet has provided us with but another way to spread knowledge of the Brougham to the entire world. Our counter is indicating that we have had almost 900 visitors. There is a lot of interest in the Brougham as evidenced by these numbers. I'm sure there will be more Broughams on the net as as time goes by. I would like to some colors other than black. How about you?

This 1957 Cadillac Series 70 Eldorado Brougham was a limited-volume hand-built four-door hardtop sedan designed by Ed Glowacke. It was the first American pillarless hardtop four-door sedan and was distinguished by a brushed stainless steel roof and the first appearance of quad headlights. It differed from other Cadillac sedans in that it had "suicide" doors. Every possible luxury was included in this car, intended as a rival to the Rolls-Royce, including automatic trunk lid opener, Cruise Control, automatic memory seats and Arpege perfume dispenser, among many others. Buyers had a choice of 44 leather upholstery combinations and could select mouton, Karakul or lambskin carpeting. The Eldorado Brougham cost \$13,074 new, a little more than a Rolls-Royce that year. Cadillac's top-selling conventional hardtop sedan that year cost \$5,539. Only 400 of the '57 Broughams were built.

Congratulations To Ed Pentesco





Our cover car made quite a splash at the Trillium C.L.C. meet in Huntsville, Canada. Ed Pentesco's 1960 Brougham garnered THE MOST RARE CADILLAC AWARD and seemed to amaze the participants at the event. To quote from the Trillium Cronicle says it all. "But by far the most notable Cadillac on display was the one made in Italy and lovingly restored in St. Catharines, Ontario. Not many Cadillac shows ever have a 1957 to 1960 Eldorado Brougham on display, but TCLC member Ed Pentesco chose our Deerhurst event to unveil the culmination of years of restoration of his 1960 Eldorado Brougham, number 55 of 101 produced for 1960. Stunning and awesome are apt descriptions for a gleaming Ebony sedan with an all black pleated leather interior (even the headliner is leather) which sits only two or three inches above the ground! Some spectators, unaware of the history of this rare Cadillac, wondered if it was a lowrider. Well, not for long, because quite a crowd gathered when the Eldorado Brougham's engine was fired up to start the air compressor doing its formidable task of raising the 5000 Lb. King-of-the-road to its fully stately and regal ride height. TCLC members were treated to a pretty rare sight as, as the air compressor slowly raised the Eldorado Brougham to its correct altitude, because so many of these Broughams were converted to mechanical suspension by Cadillac dealers under warranty in the early 1960's. Air ride was a marvel back then but, now, we marvel at the notion that Cadillac thought it could make air ride work reliably back then. It came as no surprise that the award for the rarest Cadillac was captured by Ed Pentesco's 1960 Eldorado Brougham. But even among the few remaining 1959 and and 1960 Eldorado Broughams, Ed's has also achieved a singular claim to fame. So rare is this car and so rarely are they trailered to car shows, it was amazing to learn that Ed's Brougham was driven all the way from St. Catharines to Huntsville to attend this TCLC event. Of all the Broughams in the world, this is probably the longest trip any of them has driven in a decade! Ed, your fellow Trillium Cadillac & La Salle Club members salute you for your dedication, perseverance and fanaticism above and beyond the call of Cadillac duty."


THE HIGHER STANDARD PHOTO CONTEST:

These are high quality, high density aluminum sand castings. I would be selling you the raw castings, unfinished and not plated. The price will range from \$575.00 each to \$675.00 each depending on how many I have the foundry manufacture. I can't nail down the price any closer because I literally get a price break on every single one they do at a time. I'm doing the bumpers for love of the Brougham and your price will only be over my costs to cover expenses. August 31st will be the deadline for ordering. 

- PLASTIC CUP HOLDER: Have had a major set back. Spent thousands on tooling, mold company destroyed injection tool mold trying to make minor corrections, then went out of business; taking my deposit with them!
