



Dear BOA Members and Airbag Hopefuls,

We have great news and bad news regarding air bag reproduction project.

The bad news is our costs have nearly tripled since this projects inception, due to several major unforeseen complexities which are far too technical to explain here. Secondly orders have fallen far short of original expections, and third we are quite a bit behind our original schedule for final production.

Due to the previously mentioned factors the original price we quoted will have to be increased slightly before we can go into production. More specifics will be forthcoming as final costs are know.

Now for the great news. All tooling and development has been done on metal ring inserts. We will order production run this week, production on rear bag stud plates is already complete.

Molds have been built for rubber forming and we now have at our faculty one rear and one front 90% prototype airbag. While not the final incarnation they look extremely good and show great promise. They are a wonderful sight after eight years of dreaming! These sample parts have under gone cycle tests at the factory as well as successful X-Ray tests to check for proper cord distribution and ring positioning (no easy task, let me tell you).

To perform a static test in an actual car we have installed one rear under the worst possible conditions, a lite coat of silicone, without the aid of my usual sealing techniques. It held air for approximately one week, gradually leaking down around the outer edge seal. It performed exactly the same as all of the N.O.S. bags I've used in the past. Next we removed it and reinstalled it with the aid of a sealing technique we've developed. To date the car has been up for seven weeks (this has to be a world record).

We have determined by this that we have a part approximately equal to N.O.S. with same factory short comings (outer edge seal). This type of outer edge seal is known as a chevron seal. They are commonly used on aircraft strut packing, and manufacture of these is a highly technical specialty all its own. With a bit more development time the manufacture should be able to give us a better than N.O.S. part when we make our next prototype and production run. Need;ess to say this is not your ordinary air spring!


Currently we are ordering production run of metal rings, after which we will be able to run more prototypes for dynamic testing. We will put sereveral thousand miles on a test vehicle we've recently acquired, then remove the air bags for examination by myself and the manufacture. If all goes smoothly, and I expect it will, we should then be ready for final production run..



# RESTORATION AND MAINTENANCE







The time will come when it will be necessary for you to remove the front clip of your Brougham either for service to units not otherwise accessible or to detail the engine compartment to perfection. The manual is pretty clear on the general procedure for removal; however, a few tips are in order to insure that all goes well and no damage occurs as a result of your effort to improve your car. The Brougham, which is in general built like a tank, does have a few sheet metal weakspots mainly in the front clip. You must likely have noticed the dents along the top of the fenders caused by elbows in the wrong place when servicing the engine. Most all Broughams will have these distracting little dents. Rule one: keep the elbows off the section between the hood and the fender louvers. The other, and more serious weekspot, is at the lower wheelwell extensions. You will not notice this until you remove the entire clip and start to ask yourself "what do I do now?" If you simply set the clip down as it came off the car, you are in trouble. The problem is, you will not notice the damage until it's too late. The extensions will not support the weight of the clip with out giving (buckling) and distorting the panels. On re-installation they will stick out like two giant air scoops thus destroying the perfect flatness of the car when viewed down the side. Body shops will nine times out of ten cause this type of damage if not warned in advance of the potential problem. My second Brougham's clip was all but ruined by this oversight. To properly support the clip after removal, four 55 gallon drums should be ready and waiting to accept the clip. When properly positioned they will keep the extensions from contacting the ground thus preventing any damage from occurring. The only other alternative is to flip the entire unit and rest it outside down on blankets until you are ready to install the clip. The problem within this method is that you could distort the cross over panel if the flip is not done in perfect unison with your helper. It may be necessary to flip the unit for painting the underside, but you must use great care in doing so. Once you have removed a clip from a Brougham, you will find that the whole operation can be done in about an hour or less. You will be amazed at the things you can reach with this section removed.


P.S. I almost forgot. Remember to keep the fender shims together and marked as to where they go. If not, you will have a real time of it trying to level the front clip.

We will have to approach this much the way we order our custom dyed mouton skins, wait till we have enough orders prior to production. As with the mouton we must order far more trunk material than what is necessary for one car to get tanneries and mills to run custom dye lots. This of course causes delays, but assures best results.




