#### THE 1960 CADILLAC ELDORADO BROUGHAM

The new and elegant 1960 Eldorado Brougham now is in limited production, according to Harold G. Warner, general manager of Cadillac Motor Car Division and vice president of General Motors.

Setting it apart from the other 12 Cadillac models, the Brougham has classic and distinctive styling, while featuring exclusive exterior colors and the fine interior furnishings owners expect in a car of this kind. And every bit of equipment on the Brougham is standard.

"Built to customer order, the limited production Brougham is the finest expression of the finest Cadillac we have ever offered," Warner said. "For the third successive year the suggested manufacturer's price remains unchanged at \$13,075."

From the distinctive jewel-like grille to the finely tapered rear fender fins, the classic look of the design is evident from any angle. Also at first glance it is readily apparent that the Cadillac stylists have borrowed from the distinctive

Brougham design for their styling of the standard Cadillac models.

The careful attention to detail and restrained use of chrome achieves new heights. Chrome usage is held to narrow edgings and accents of body shapes and contours. An excellent example of this is the chrome edging that caps the flared molding on the bottom of the rear quarter panels. This flare carried forward to the front wheel opening.

This new Brougham retains the classic look achieved by the bold use of glass and the flat roof line which is obliquely contoured along each side. And again this year the small rear quarter windows recess as the rear doors are opened to facilitate ease of entrance and exit to the spacious rear seat.

Mechanically the Brougham incorporates all of the engineering excellence of the standard 1960 Cadillac line. The car is powered with the 345 horsepower Eldorado engine and the new slim-line Hydra-Matic.

Among the outstanding new engineering features shared with the standard models are Cadillac's 1960 brakes, further improvements in ride and handling and engine refinements.

In keeping with the classic design, the Brougham owner has 15 exclusive exterior colors from which to choose. The matching

all line-

attilline

or harmonizing interior combinations also are exclusive to the Brougham and are of the finest of wool broadcloths or top grain leathers.

To go with the custom tailoring of the interiors, the distinctive appointments include two storage compartments on the package

shelf behind the rear seat, individual door courtesy lights, red warning lights that shine when the doors are opened and a clock mounted in a mahogany panel in the back of the front seat.

As standard equipment, the Brougham includes many of the items classified as optional on most automobiles, ranging from cruise control and air conditioning to the power operated trunk opener.

Among these are air suspension, power operated ventipane windows, radio, heater, six-way power seat, Guide-Matic headlamp control, E-Z eye glass, vacuum door locks and fog lamps.

The over-all length of the Brougham remains at 225 inches while it stands 55 inches in height and is 80 inches wide.





#### **OPINIONS, QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

From Art Levine: I would like to express my opinion on the article in Vol.8, No.3 about the 57 Brougham "street rod". I often thought of doing a similar thing to my 1960; but, hate to stray from original since the limited production makes it rare. But if I did do it I would not go so extreme as front wheel drive - but, maybe the latest rear wheel drive and trans. That way I could always go back to original. How does the following effect the judging at a National Cadillac meet? Changing the color, but still using a color of that year? Changing the seat material from the name tag to another available material? Changing carpet material? Would any of these changes effect the value?

Let there be know doubt that an original car will always be worth more than an altered car. The following judging materials from CLC should answer the other questions you asked.

#### PROCEDURES - CLC GRAND NATIONAL JUDGING

The rules and procedures below shall be followed at all Cadillac-LaSalle Club Grand National Meets to ensure uniformity and continuity. Their use is optional at other meets, but Class Status changes (Senior, etc.) in the National Club will normally not occur.

GENERAL - Entrants must be National members in good standing of the Cadillac-LaSalle Club, Inc. to participate and receive Grand National Awards. The CLC membership number will be listed on the judging sheet and windshield card. Membership application forms shall be available at each Grand National Meet for those desirous of joining the Cadillac-LaSalle Club, Inc. Vehicles to be eligible for judging must be "owned" by a CLC member. All eligible vehicles shall be judged on their own merits within assigned classes. There will be no "cursory prejudging.

Vehicles "for exhibition only" at the owner's option will be so honored.

VEHICLE SERIAL NUMBER (V.I.N.#) - Required for National's records, to keep track of cars that have become Senior, etc.

DISQUALIFICATIONS, AUTOMATIC - No U.L. approved Fire Extinguisher; An engine that was never used by Cadillac or LaSalle.

DEDUCTIONS, AUTOMATIC - An incorrect engine design, chassis or a non-authentic body will result in a deduction of eleven (11) points from the Final Score. Additional deductions may be appropriate in other categories. The owner of a questionable vehicle may apply to the Vehicle Review Committee for a ruling on said specific vehicle.

JUDGING - Grand National Meet judging will be conducted by the host region. National judging forms, procedures and rules shall be used to provide continuity and uniform standards. The National Chief Judge and/or the National Deputy Chief Judge(s) will be available to help the host region with judging matters and shall be the final authority.

Judging will be impartial, fair and professional. Every effort will be made to utilize knowledgeable and interested teams of judges. No judge may judge a class in which he has a vehicle entered for judging, including any vehicle upon which he/she may have performed major restoration and/or repair work.

All deductions for authenticity must be identified on the judging form; team leader must discuss with owner/exhibitor and then initial "approved deductions," or cross out nondeductible items. In case of reasonable doubt, the opinion of the owner shall prevail.

Fractional point deductions are NOT allowed. Awards will be made for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

Tie scores - duplicate awards will be made. Vehicles with Final Scores less than one point apart shall be considered as "Tied" (applies to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in all classes). All Vehicles scoring 98 points or higher will receive a First Place Award.

SAFETY ITEMS such as Seat Belts and Battery Disconnect switches installed in a workman like manner - NO Deduction.

SCORE AVERAGING - The High and Low scores will be eliminated and the two middle scores averaged. If only three (3) judges are used, all three scores will be averaged. Note: Actual scores will not be disclosed at

PHILOSOPHY - All vehicles in whatever state of repair are encouraged to be shown, but only vehicles that are safe to drive shall be driven to, or on to, the meet grounds. No one need be embarrassed about the condition of his vehicle. Various divisions and classes are designed to provide a respected place of recognition for every Cadillac or LaSalle within the confines of these stated objectives.

DIVISIONS AND CLASSES - Judging of vehicles is designed to further the enjoyment of the hobby. The preservation, maintenance and restoration of all Cadillacs and LaSalles are encouraged. Modifications, non-authentic customizing and/or a deliberate effort to deface the original condition of a Cadillac or LaSalle are not within the purposes and objectives of the Cadillac-LaSalle Club, Inc.

Classes may be combined and/or divided as deemed appropriate by the National Chief Judge (or Deputy[s] if Chief Judge is not readily available).

Vehicles, to be judged, must register by the Monday prior to the show. Host Region may set a reasonable earlier deadline.

DEPARTURE FORM — All Judged Vehicles upon leaving the field must turn in their DEPARTURE FORM; Departure PRIOR to the Designated End of Meet Time (without prior approval of a Chief or Deputy Judge), or non-submittal of this Form will result in disqualification and the vehicle will not be eligible for any Class Awards.

NATIONAL JUDGING CLASSES of the Cadillac-LaSalle Club, Inc. shall consist of:

TOURING - The purpose of this class is to encourage members to drive and show their Cadillacs and LaSalles regardless of condition, with special emphasis on original unrestored cars.

Entry in this division is not mandatory!

1977 and newer cars, and all commercial vehicles will NOT be shown in Touring Class.

Awards should be small trophies.

(Vehicles must be at least 15 Model Years old.) 1: Best Original - Early J: Best Original - Middle

Considered for the "Best Considered for the "Best Original" awards must notify the meet registrar who will issue a "BEST ORIGINAL VEHICLE JUDGING APPLICATION" form that is to be filled in by the owner and returned to the Registrar. The Registrar shall forward all said forms to a Past-President. Recipients of these awards shall be selected by the Past-Presidents in attendance at the meet. If none in attendance, then by their designated representative(s).

AWARDS - All Awards are not official until: audit of judging forms is completed, factory records checked (if available), and winning position verified.

RESULTS OF JUDGING - A request, in writing along with a S.S.A.E. (addressed to the owner or exhibitor), shall be made (within 60 days of the meet) to the National Chief Judge. A synopsis of the judging results will be provided along with any pertinent notes that are on the judging forms. Actual scores are not released. All judging forms will be stored a minimum of four (4) years. A record of all first place Primary awards shall be kept indefinitely by the National Chief


CLASS STATUS CHANGE - Senior Vehicle Owners, after a period of four (4) years, may request that their car revert to Primary Status or to Touring Class. Such application shall be made in writing to the National Chief Judge. If granted, the change is irrevocable and shall remain in effect until such time that the car again wins a first place in Primary. The badge may be retained, but will be invalid. It will again be valid should the car place first in Primary at a future meet (a new badge will not be issued). Any Car may enter the Touring Class at any time if it

has not won a first in Primary or Touring. Four (4) years after winning a first place in Touring Class a car may once again enter Touring Class. (no request required unless it has won a 1st in Primary, then see above).

\*\* SENIOR BADGES - Badges are issued after judging results are audited etc. (see AWARDS above).

Mike will be installing this set on a Brougham for the acid test during the coming week. I'm told that the wear spot in the original design has been corrected and x-ray analysis indicates that the cord distribution is better tan the originals due to improved manufacturing processes. Goodyear is going to do further testing in the U.S. to determine if there are any additional improvements to make. This is indeed an exiting moment in Brougham restoration. These parts have always been the worst stumbling block in proper Brougham restoration. A lot of dedicated Brougham owners have been waiting for this moment for years. The waiting is over, testing is underway and Broughams will again be riding with pride on air! The fact that many weaknesses in the originals have been corrected means that the next set you buy will be the last as the problem of longevity is behind us. Mike's drive tests will be in Vol. 9 No. 3 due in October.


